

1. TECHNICAL INFORMATION

1.1. Timetable changes

Please, refer to the timetable published at the European Athletics' and Event websites, and also at the online platform for final confirmations.

The changes occurred are mostly for the qualification rounds in the track events due to very high number of entries in those events.

On the contrary, due to several withdrawals in the Pole Vault Women, we had to cancel the Qualification round for that event on Friday AM session. There will be straight final on Saturday PM with 11 athletes (starting at 18:45).

1.2. Call Room Schedule

1.5 Combined Events

Combined Events' athletes will exit the infield through the Mixed Zone after each event, except the following:

Pentathlon:

- Not after 60m Hurdles (straight to the High Jump)
- Not after High Jump (quickly to the CE rest room and straight to the Shot Put)

Heptathlon:

- Not after 60m (straight to the Long Jump)
- Not after 60m H (straight to the Pole Vault)



1.6 Coaching Areas

Coaches for field events shall assemble in front of the Call Room 10 min before the warm-up start in order to be escorted to the coaches' seats.

2. ATHLETES' INTRODUCTION

<u>All finalists</u> will enter the field of play (FOP) via the Athlete Entry GATE located nearby the Call Room

60m & 60mH, 400m and 4x400m

- The athletes (first leg runner in the relays) will enter the FOP and set their blocks before being escorted to the Athlete Entry GATE
- They will then be introduced in lane order.
- For the relays, athletes will be introduced team by team.

800m, 800m Pentathlon, 1000m Heptathlon, 1500m & 3000m

• The athletes will be introduced one by one from the Athlete Entry GATE before making their way to the start line.

Field Event Finals

- The athletes will enter the FOP and warm up as normal.
- A few minutes before the start of competition, they will be escorted from the FOP to the Athlete Entry GATE when they will be introduced in start list order.


Procedure:

For all athletes entering via the Athlete Entry GATE, the following procedure should be followed:

- All finalists will gather behind the Athlete Entry GATE before their event
- A Floor Manager will arrange them in the presentation order at the left and right side of the gate entrance, / = start list order/
- Once the Presentation starts the Floor Manager will give each athlete a sign to enter the gate.
- After entering a gate each athlete shall stop for a while in front of the camera /watch the floor mark/ and greet the audience /wave, smile, up to you :-) /. This is very important as this is when the Host Broadcaster will identify them with graphics
- Once introduced, the Floor Manager will give the athlete a sign to leave the gate and enter the field of play.

3. VICTORY CEREMONIES

All the Victory Ceremonies will take place at the Arena Torun.

Athletes are requested to arrive at the VC preparation room 20 minutes prior to the ceremony. Athletes having a ceremony right after their event will be picked up at the end of the Mixed Zone/ Kit Collection and taken to the VC preparation room.



For those athletes having a ceremony later in the day or the following day, the meeting point will be at the TIC. A "WhatsApp" text message indicating the meeting time will be sent to the respective Team Leader.

All athletes are required to wear a surgical mask provided by the LOC. It is permitted to remove the masks only at the end of the ceremony for the purpose of taking pictures keeping the social distancing.

The athletes will put on disinfected medals in the VC preparation room and will enter VC area already with medals on.

Athletes must wear the official team clothing for the ceremonies and the presentation bibs provided by the LOC. No other items shall be taken to the podium such as flags, bags or other.
