C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

C.1. Compliance with the Olympic Charter and other relevant rules

All athletes must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions).



Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the IOC, plus the rules of *Name of the IF*, may participate in the Olympic Games Paris 2024.

C.2. Additional IF eligibility criteria

Only the athletes who are eligible to participate at the main official competitions of FIBA, in accordance with the FIBA Internal Regulations applicable at the relevant point in time, are entitled to participate in the Olympic Games.

2. The competition format for each region shall be decided by the FIBA Central Board. Five (5) teams from the FIBA Olympic Pre-Qualifying Tournaments will qualify directly for the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournaments as follows:
 - Africa: 1 team
 - Americas: 1 team
 - Asia (including Oceania): 1 team
 - Europe: 2 teams
3. Should any of the invited teams not accept the invitation or for any other reason be unable to participate, the next highest ranked team(s) who has not directly qualified from the same continent will be invited to participate unless otherwise decided by the FIBA Central Board.

Participation in the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournaments (FOQTs) 2024

1. Twenty-four (24) teams, representing all continents, are eligible to participate in the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournaments 2024 as follows:

The highest placed teams from Africa, Americas and Asia (3 in total), not directly qualified for the Olympic Games from the previous FIBA Basketball World Cup will be invited to participate in the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournaments. 3. The next sixteen (16) highest placed teams not directly qualified for the Olympic Games from the previous FIBA Basketball World Cup, regardless of their continent of origin, will be invited to participate in the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournaments. 4. The highest placed teams not yet qualified from the FIBA Olympic Pre-Qualifying Tournaments (1 from Africa, 1 from Americas, 1 from Asia and 2 from Europe) will be invited to participate in the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournaments. 5. Should any of the invited teams not accept the invitation, the next highest placed team(s) who has not directly qualified from the same continent will be invited to participate unless otherwise decided by the FIBA Central Board. 6. The twenty-four (24) participating teams will be divided into four (4) tournaments of six (6) teams each. 7. Each tournament shall be hosted by one (1) of the six (6) participating national federations. 8. In principle, each continent shall host one (1) FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournament. 9. - The above numbers shall include the FWBWC 2022 winner, if not from Europe.
- Should any of the invited teams not accept the invitation or for any other reason be unable to participate, the next highest ranked team(s) who has(ve) not directly qualified from the same continent will be invited to participate unless otherwise decided by the FIBA Central Board.
- The twenty-two (22) participating teams will be divided into two (2) tournaments of four (4) teams in Asia and Americas and one (1) tournament of six (6) teams in Africa.
- The groups will be composed of the teams from the same continent/geographical region (in case of Asia and Oceania).
- Each tournament shall be hosted by one (1) of the participating national federations.
- The top two (2) teams of each tournament shall qualify for the FWOQTs. In case the FWBWC winner is in the group, this teams will qualify directly and the second team from the respective group according to the result.

****FIBA Central Board reserves the right to confirm if the FWOPQT will take place by 1st June 2023. In case the FWOPQTs are not played, the below specified number of teams per continent will qualify for the FWOQTs directly from the FIBA Women's Continental Cups 2023.**

Participation in the FIBA Women's Olympic Qualifying Tournaments (FWOQT)

- Sixteen (16) teams, representing all continents/geographical regions, are qualified for the FWOQTs as follows:

- The above numbers shall include the OG **host country** and the FWBWC 2022 winner
- The sixteen (16) participating teams will be divided into four (4) tournaments of four (4) teams each.
- Each tournament shall be hosted by one (1) of the four (4) participating national federations.
- In order to implement the universality principle, at least one of the groups should contain two teams from the same continent/geographical region, as decided by FIBA.
- In principle, each continent/geographical region should host one (1) of the FWOQTs.



	<p>7. The highest placed three (3) teams from each of the Tournaments shall qualify for the Women's Olympic Basketball Tournament. HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The FIBA Central Board may decide to grant the automatic qualification place to the Men's and Women's teams of the host country. The FIBA Central Board will determine the precise criteria **by 31.12.2022** the latest. This decision will be made **by 30.06.2023**.

E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

CONFIRMATION OF QUOTA PLACES

FIBA will publish the final results after each qualification event on the official website (www.fiba.basketball) and inform the qualified NOCs/NFs accordingly.

The NOCs will then have two (2) weeks to confirm if they wish to use these quota places, as detailed in paragraph G. Qualification Timeline.

For the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournaments, the NOC/NF must confirm their participation to the Olympic Games to FIBA should they qualify at the same time as registering their team(s) for the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournaments, namely **by 30 November 2023**.

F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

The following applies in case a quota place: i) is not confirmed by the respective NOC within the applicable deadline, or ii) is declined or iii) the NOC/NF is unable to use the quota place for any reason whatsoever:

If the quota place is allocated at the FBWC 2023 or at the FOPQTs, the quota place will be reallocated to the next highest-ranked NOC not yet qualified, from the respective event where the quota place was obtained, taking into consideration geographical criteria if applicable to such quota place.



If the quota place is allocated at the FIBA Women's Continental Cups or the FWOPQTs, the quota place will be reallocated to the next highest-ranked NOC not yet qualified, from the respective event where the quota place was obtained.

If the quota place is allocated at the FOQTs or FWOQTs, then the place will be reallocated to the next highest ranked team not yet qualified from the respective FOQT or FWOQT.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES

In case the automatic qualification places are not granted to the host country by the FIBA Central Board, or in case the host country declines the automatic qualification places or is for any reason whatsoever unable to use them, FIBA will reallocate those place(s) to the next highest placed team(s) from the FBWC 2023 (the best classified among those teams not directly qualified for the OG) and FIBA Women's Olympic Qualifying Tournaments (11th team from the Tournaments). In case France accepts the host country place but is also granted a quota place as the best European team at the FBWC 2023, the quota place will be reallocated the next highest ranked team from Europe at the FBWC 2023.
